San Diego Dance Theater's annual spring dance concert is a model of creative partnering. In addition to continuing a long-time collaboration with SDSU graduate design students in lighting, costume and set design, San Diego Dance Theater is partnering with the San Diego Visual Arts Network to incorporate the work of Cardiff fabric designer Rosemary KimBal.
