All In-school activities are directed by San Diego dance legend, Artistic Director Jean Isaacs and performed by company dancers.

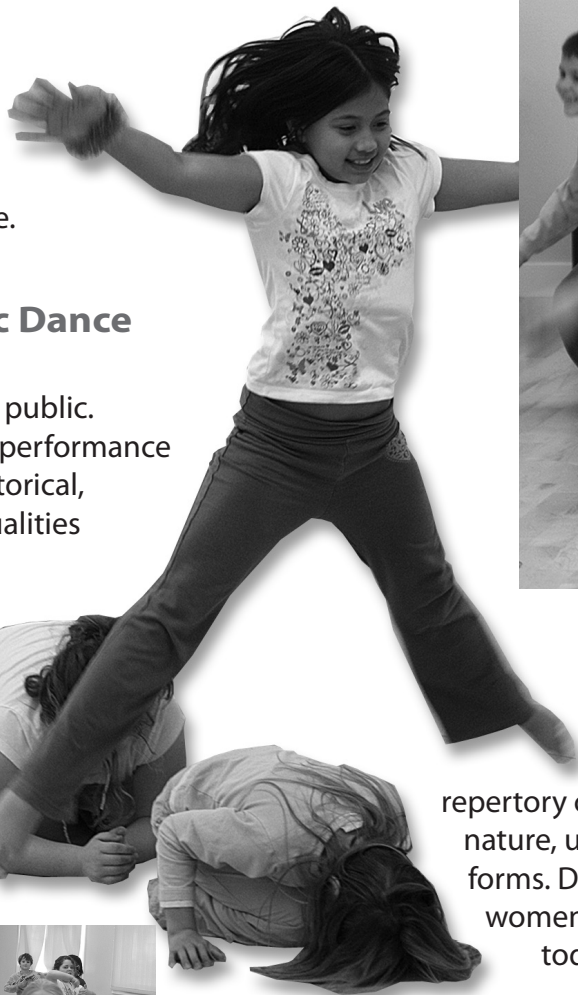
