



Children's Classes Pricing & Policies - Fall 2026

Pricing

SDDT aims to provide a wonderful class experience for your children. Registration costs make it possible for SDDT to pay teachers competitively, have access to beautiful studio space, and keep our programs running smoothly.

- **Creative Movement** - \$252 for the Fall Session, paid upon registration
 - This breaks down to approximately \$18 per class
- **Ballet/Tap, Hip Hop, Ballet/Jazz** - \$322 for the Fall Session, paid upon registration
 - This breaks down to approximately \$23 per class
- **Note:** Pricing may vary depending on which day of the week you select to take class due to Holiday and other closures. See precise pricing for each course when you visit the booking page on our website.

Important Dates

- **Session Start:** Wednesday, September 2nd
- **Session End:** Thursday, December 10th
- **Closures:** On the below dates, there will be no Children's classes at SDDT.
 - Veteran's Day: Wednesday, November 11th
 - Thanksgiving Week: Wednesday, November 25th and Thursday, November 26th

Program Policies

SDDT teachers work diligently every day to provide quality instruction to our students. Please help your child succeed in our classes by following these guidelines:

1. Each child enrolled in class must have already reached the minimum age for that class's particular age group by the time the session begins.
2. No parents, siblings, friends, etc are allowed inside the studio during class. To reduce noise and distractions, parents/guardians/visitors must view class from one of our many hallway windows. Please do not interrupt class.
3. Be prepared for class by arriving on time, and making sure your child uses the bathroom before class begins. Class is closed 10 minutes after the start time.
4. A parent or guardian must be present on campus at all times. Our studio is located in a building accessible to the public, and we cannot monitor who has access to the hallways. For the safety of each student, we request that parents are present in the hallway during the duration of class.
5. No food or beverages are allowed inside the studio except for water. Snacks and drinks can be enjoyed in the hallway and all trash must be tossed in the hallway trash.
6. Please communicate with your teacher if your child needs extra support. On the rare occasion that your child's teacher invites you to be present inside of the studio to provide additional support to your child, please do not cause any distractions (eating, talking on the phone, etc).
7. Any outstanding payments must be paid by the first day of class. If you have an outstanding balance after the first class, you may be dropped from the class.



Dress Codes

Creative Movement, Ballet/Jazz, & Ballet/Tap

- **Option A:** Leotard (any color) and pink or skin-tone tights or bike shorts. Skirts optional. If your dancer chooses to wear a skirt, we prefer one that is attached to the leotard. Ballet shoes required (without laces preferred). If ballet shoes have laces, please tie them in a knot, and cut off the excess string afterwards. This helps to minimize the time our teachers spend tying laces and skirts. **Tap shoes required for Ballet/Tap only.**
- **Option B:** Form-fitting tank or t-shirt (any color), and black leggings. Ballet shoes required (without laces preferred). If ballet shoes have laces, please tie them in a knot, and cut off the excess string afterwards. This helps to minimize the time our teachers spend tying laces and skirts. **Tap shoes required for Ballet/Tap only.**
- **Please Avoid:** Allowing your child to wear distracting clothing or accessories, or anything that could cause a tripping hazard (tails, costumes with bulky or long details, cat ears, jewelry that is easy to remove, etc).

Hip Hop:

- Comfortable clothes and sneakers. Examples: leggings and a t-shirt, sweatpants or sweat-shorts and a tank top. *Clothes to avoid:* anything rigid like jeans, anything with difficult fastenings like overalls.
- **Please Avoid:** Allowing your child to wear distracting clothing or accessories, or anything that could cause a tripping hazard (tails, costumes with bulky or long details, cat ears, jewelry that is easy to remove, etc).
